

# Security Incentive Scheme 2021/2022

## Working together for a safe community.

Community safety is everyone's responsibility. This Scheme aims to support Canning residents to improve the level of security within and around their property.

Item/Device	Standard Rebate	Concession Card Rebate only
Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) System	\$100	\$200
Home Intruder Alarm	\$100	\$200
Door deadlocks (per lock)	\$30	\$60
Keyed window locks (per lock)	\$30	\$60
Security sensor light	\$60	\$120
Security screen door (per door)	\$60	\$120
Security window screen (per window)	\$30	\$60

### Eligibility:

To be eligible for the Scheme, you must comply with the following:

- All security devices must be supplied and installed by a registered business that holds a valid Security Installer's License, and sensor lights by a registered electrician.
- You must be a resident within the City of Canning, **OR**
- Be the property owner, an agent authorised to act on their behalf, or a tenant with signed consent from one of these,

### How does the Security Incentive Scheme work?:

- Applicants can install multiple security items in their home, however the maximum rebate provided will be capped at **\$100 per household, per financial year** or **\$200** for applicants that hold a valid Pensioner, WA Seniors or Healthcare Concession Card.
- Property investors within the City of Canning are entitled to make **one application, per financial year** to the value of \$100, or \$200 should they be an eligible concession card holder.
- Once the work is completed and the amount has been paid to the service provider in full, submit this application along with a fully itemised Tax Invoice, a bank statement confirming the details of the nominated bank account for deposit of the rebate and other relevant documentation to apply for a rebate.
- The application will be assessed and, if approved, the prescribed rebate amount will be deposited into the nominated bank account.  
**NB: Please allow up to 20 business days for applications to be assessed and approved.**

### Security Suppliers:

- A list of suppliers based within the City is provided at the end of this application.
- Self installed items or items that are purchased through a business without a security installers or electrical license are NOT eligible for a rebate.
- **Security devices must be supplied and installed by a registered business with a valid Security Installer's License, and sensor lights by a registered electrician.**

### Conditions:

- The date on the Tax Invoice provided for the completion of works must relate to after the previous round of the Security Incentive Scheme (1 November 2020).
- Applications received before July 1 will not be accepted.
- The date on the Tax Invoice for the completion of works must relate to after the previous round of the Security Incentive Scheme (1 November 2020). Applications received with a Tax Invoice dated prior to 1 November 2020 will not be accepted.
- The City provides no guarantee that a Security Incentive Scheme rebate will be provided to all eligible applicants if the allocated budget is expended prior to the end of the financial year. Contact the Safe Communities team on 1300 422 664 for more information.

## How do I apply for the Security Incentive Scheme?

### STEP 1: Obtain quotes

- It is recommended you obtain more than one quote to ensure you receive the best price for the works
- The quotes must be itemised
- Decide which supplier you'd like to complete the works
- Ensure that you keep a copy of the final quote

### STEP 2: Complete the works

- Have the security item(s) installed in your home
- Pay the service provider in full
- Ensure you receive a fully itemised Tax Invoice.
  - **NB: Your application will not be processed without a fully paid (\$0.00 balance), itemised Tax Invoice. Bank transfer confirmation or eftpos receipts are insufficient and you will be required to contact the service provider to obtain a copy prior to your application being approved.**

### STEP 3: Lodge your application

- Complete this application form in full
- Forward the application, including a copy of the itemised Tax Invoice, a bank statement confirming the bank details of the nominated bank account for deposit of the rebate and a copy of your Pensioner, Health Care or Seniors Card (if applicable) to the City of Canning via:

# Security Incentive Scheme 2021/2022

## Application Checklist:

Before submitting your application, ensure you have the following:

- Completed Security Incentive Scheme Application form, with ALL signatures
- A copy of the PAID tax invoice (\$0.00 balance) from the security provider. Bank transfer confirmation or eftpos receipts will not be accepted.
- A copy of a bank statement header including the Account Holder Name, BSB and Account Number of the nominated account for deposit of rebate (transaction and balance details are not required), and; (a copy of any concession cards (if applicable)).

Applications are open until the **30 June 2022**, however the City provides no guarantee a rebate will be provided to all eligible applicants if the funds have been fully expended prior to this date.

Once submitted, the City will review your application, and advise you of the outcome either by email or telephone.

Once approved, the rebate amount will be deposited into your nominated bank account.

**NB: Please allow up to 20 business days for an application outcome to be received.**
