

Mid-Tier Transport Consortium for Perth Metropolitan Area – Supporting Metronet

A consortium of 15 local governments have identified 15 priority mid-tier transport routes intended to complement METRONET by improving connections between rail stations and activity centres. The identification of potential mid-tier routes has catalysed the advocacy process demonstrating how Mid-Tier Transport can:

- Bridge the nexus between climate, liveability, congestion and housing diversity and affordability
- Strengthen the METRONET network
- Build a public transport network that will deliver the necessary infrastructure to support a growing population in Perth

This project seeks the support of State Government for the following:

1. Preparation for a holistic Mid-Tier Transport Strategy for Perth
2. Funding for the plan over the 2023/24 and 2024/25 budget cycles
3. Provide certainty for LGAs and the development industry to accommodate for state urban infill targets partly by coordinating development.



This corridor plan summarises the technical assessment and stakeholder coordination conducted for the consortium of 15 local governments across the Perth metropolitan area only. Further investigation is required.
