

Building Information Sheet: Work where a building permit is not required

The following work does not require a building permit, as listed under Clause 2, Schedule 4 of the Building Regulations 2012:

- Construction, erection, assembly or placement of a freestanding non-habitable building (private garage, carport, shed or the like) that
 - a. Has a floor area not exceeding 10m²; and
 - b. Is no more than 2.4m in height
- 2. Renovations, alteration, improvement repair or maintenance of a building if the work
 - a. Does not affect its structural soundness of the building and does not include
 - i. changing the floor area or height of the building
 - ii. affecting existing footings
 - iii. the removal of any structural elements

and

- b. is done with similar materials that are commonly used for the same purpose
- c. does not change the building's classification
- d. does not affect the health and safety of the occupants or the public
- e. will not affect the way the structure complies with relevant standards
- f. does not affect any adjoining land
- g. is not carried out on heritage listed buildings
- Construction, erection, assembly or placement of a temporary office, shed or sanitary facility to be used by a builder in connection with building work
- 4. Construction, erection, assembly or placement of a fence, screen or similar structure if—
 - a. The fence, screen or similar structure is constructed in accordance with the City's Local Laws (Part 14)

or

- b. If constructed of masonry, is no higher than 0.75m; and
- c. If constructed of a material other than masonry, is no higher than 1.8m.

Please note that fencing around swimming pools is not exempt from the requirement for a building permit





- Construction, erection, assembly or placement or a mast, antenna or similar structure that
 - a. If attached to a building
 - i. Is no more than 2m in height above the point where it is attached
 - ii. Will not have any significant effect on the building
 - b. If not attached to the building, is no more than 3m in height.
- 6. Construction, erection, assembly or placement of a retaining wall that
 - a. Retains ground no more than 0.5m in height; and
 - b. Is not associated with other building work or with the protection of land adjoining the land on which the retaining wall is located (i.e. cut);
 - c. And does not have any effect on adjoining land.
- 7. Construction, erection, assembly or placement of a pergola that
 - a. Is no more than 2.4m in height; and
 - b. Covers an area not exceeding 20m².
- 8. Construction, erection, assembly or placement of a **water storage tank** with a capacity of 5000L or less.
- 9. Building work for a park home or annexe as those terms are defined in the *Caravan Parks and Camping Grounds Act 1995* section 5(1).
- 10. Attachment of solar panels or solar hot water systems to the roof of a single dwelling or a non-habitable building associated with a residential dwelling.
