


# **Building Information Sheet: Portable Signs**

## **Portable Sign**

A portable sign is a self supporting sign which is not permanently fixed in position and usually takes the form of a sandwich board or 'A' frame as depicted



# **Approvals**

A licence is not required to display a portable sign, however, the following requirements must be met:

- 1. Size: Max height 1.2m Max area 1m²
- 2. Produced and maintained in a professional manner
- 3. The sign must be stable, so that it is not subject to being knocked or blown over
- 4. The sign may only advertise a product or service available on the property upon which the sign is placed
- 5. Maximum of one portable sign per business or premises
- 6. The sign should be removed from public view during the hours that the business is closed
- 7. The sign must not obstruct the vision of motorists or impede pedestrians

#### **Fees**

No application fee is required

### Setbacks

A portable sign may only be erected on private property and not at any time on the road verge, footpath or other public place

Illegal signs may be removed or impounded and/or a fine may be imposed
