ADOPTED POLICY	
<b>Title:</b>	<b>WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES – RECYCLING COLLECTION</b>
<b>Objective:</b>	<b>To provide a domestic recycling collection service.</b>

- 1.0 All residential premises shall be supplied with a mobile garbage bin (MGB) for the fortnightly collection of recyclables (yellow top bin).
- 2.0 Residents shall be requested to place their recyclables MGB (yellow top bin) on the street verge by 6.00am every second week as directed to coincide with the regular rubbish collection
- 3.0 To facilitate collection, the MGB shall be placed immediately adjacent the road kerb, with handles facing the house.
- 4.0 For health reasons, the MGB should not be overfilled to ensure that the lid can be closed
- 5.0 In the event materials left out for collection cannot be recycled, the residents shall be advised of the reason the material has not been collected.
- 6.0 Any missed services shall be collected within 24 hours of notification.
- 7.0 Extra rubbish placed on the verge alongside the MGB shall not be removed.
