ADOPTED POLICY	
Title:	WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES – VERGE RUBBISH COLLECTION
Objective:	To provide verge side collection services for bulk green waste and junk.

The City shall provide separate verge collections for junk and green waste, as determined from time to time by the City. Residents shall be advised by Annual Calendar, the City's Web Page and Local community News Papers prior to the collection week.

1.0 Junk Collection

1.1 Occupiers of residential premises depositing waste on their front verge for collection must comply with the following conditions:

- (a) Place rubbish out on street verge in a tidy pile ready for collection.
- (b) Separate junk from white goods and other recyclable items.

1.2 Acceptable types of waste that qualify for junk collection:

- (a) Old Furniture
- (b) Stoves
- (c) Refrigerators and similar white goods.

1.3 Unacceptable types of waste that will not be removed in the junk collection, and should not be placed on the verge for collection:

- (a) Bricks
- (b) Rubble
- (c) Sand
- (d) Cement
- (e) Tyres
- (f) Foodstuffs (Household)
- (g) Inflammable Products
- (h) Chemical Liquids
- (i) Motor Vehicles or Parts
- (j) Asbestos Cement Products

1.4 The City may limit the quantity of hard waste that can be deposited on the verge to the equivalent of two 6 x 4 box trailers (4m³) of material.

2.0 Green Waste Collection

2.1 Occupiers of residential premises depositing waste on their front verge for collection must comply with the following regulations:

- (a) Trim branches, pruning's and garden waste to 1.5m lengths.
- (b) Place branches with cut ends facing street.

2.2 Acceptable types of green waste include tree and shrub pruning's, leaves and lawn clippings in bags.

2.3 The Council may limit the quantity of green waste that can be deposited on the verge.
