ADOPTED POLICY	
Title:	URBAN REVEGETATION AND GREENING
Objective:	To improve the urban revegetation and greening of the City.

1.0 Streetscape Enhancement

It shall be the objective of the City to develop attractive streetscapes along arterial road reserves and within residential streets.

2.0 Environmental Rehabilitation – Community Participation

Local residents, schools and other interested groups shall be encouraged to assist with tree planting projects associated with the rehabilitation of natural areas.

3.0 Use of the City’s Nursery for Community Projects

3.1 The City will permit the use of its plant propagation facilities by community groups to assist in revegetation/greening projects where projects are of benefit to the City.

3.2 Revegetation/greening proposals from community groups shall detail:

- (a) Location and nature of project.
- (b) Name and status of volunteer organisation/community group.
- (c) Number of community group members.
- (d) Extent of works to be undertaken by volunteer/community group members.
- (e) Extent of assistance required from the City.
- (f) Follow up maintenance program.
- (g) Estimated value of project.
- (h) Funding source for program if external to City.

3.3 Where a project is approved by the City and funding is obtained, the City will plan and coordinate any necessary approvals, plant production and project design.
