ADOPTED POLICY	
<b>Title:</b>	<b>REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN ABANDONED VEHICLES</b>
<b>Objective:</b>	<b>To enable authorised officers to remove, other than by ‘impounding’, and dispose of certain abandoned vehicles found in public places within the district of the City.</b>

Upon being reasonably satisfied that an abandoned vehicle, or part thereof, has no value or that the cost of its removal, detention and tendering will exceed the amount likely to be obtained by its sale, the Manager Patrol and Security Services may deem it to be ‘litter’ within the meaning of the term as defined in the Litter Act 1979, and arrange for its appropriate disposal.
