### City of Canning requirements relating to landscaping on verges:

**On the sketch plan attached to this application, please show the dimensions of the area to be landscaped and also include**

- The location of a street tree (if present)
- The names of the proposed plants and their approximate location;
- The type and layout of any reticulation and/or paving;
- Note any existing features such as service pit covers, the crossover and the public footpath;
- Keep plants back 1.5m from the road edge if you don't have a footpath.
- You may wish to include an area for your waste and recycling bins - typically close to the crossover.

#### Please note:

- Street trees and their roots are to be protected and not pruned, or damaged during verge works.
- No plant is to be of a hazardous nature (e.g. thorny or poisonous), or taller than 700mm when mature, or must be able to be maintained at that height;
- Paving material is limited to 30% of the verge area and concrete is limited to 25%, including the crossover. If paving is approved it is to be integrated into the soft landscaping so as not to provide an area for vehicle parking;
- Artificial turf or synthetic grass is not permitted as a verge treatment;
- Loose pea gravel, crushed brick or other stone aggregates are not permitted as verge treatments;
- The verge treatment is not to impede pedestrian access;
- The general level and grade of the verge is not to be altered;
- All irrigation pipework and associated fittings are to be laid at a depth of not more than 300mm, nor less than 150mm, below ground level;
- Mulch is to be woodchips or large-particle vegetative mulch material (please specify on the sketch plan over); and
- For verges without a footpath, all plants are to be set back 1.5m from the kerb of the road.
